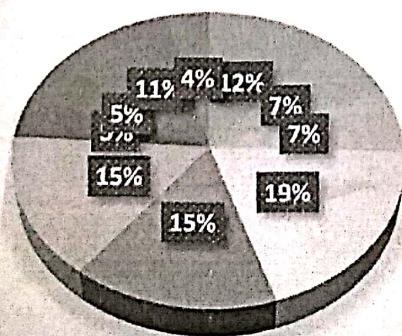

During the academic year 2022-23 Out of the all students, 129 were participated in the online survey. The results of the same are as follows:

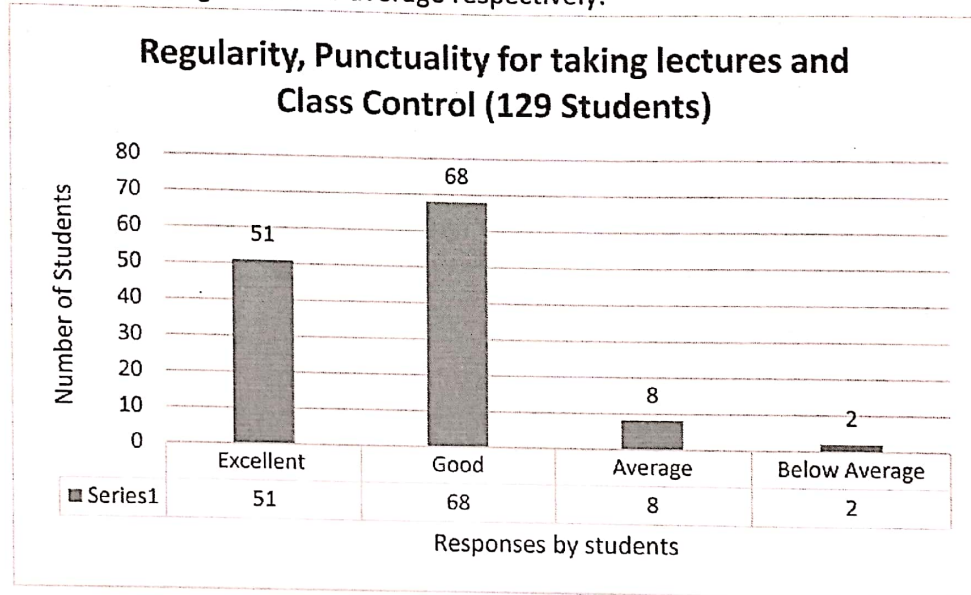

2. Regularity, Punctuality for taking lectures and Class Control.

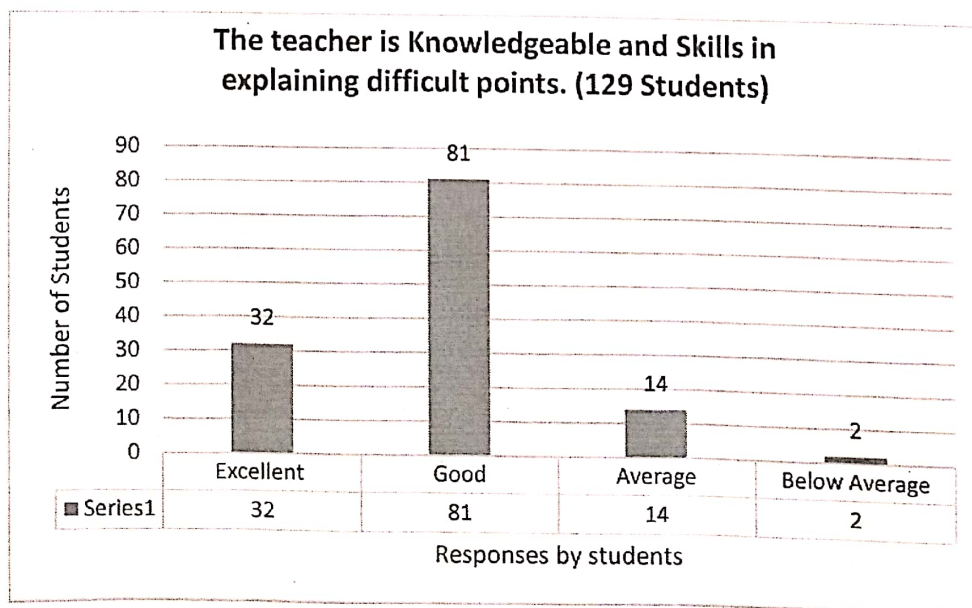
The institution always enforce teachers and students to conduct and to attend the lectures on proper time. The result of which can be seen in the feedback given by the student about regularity, punctuality for taking lectures and class control.

Out of total students 22.87% (51) says that regularity, punctuality for taking lectures and class control, is excellent. Whereas 30.49% (68) students said, it was good. Only 3.59% (8) and merely 0.90% (2) students have replied that the regularity and punctuality of teachers was average or below average respectively.



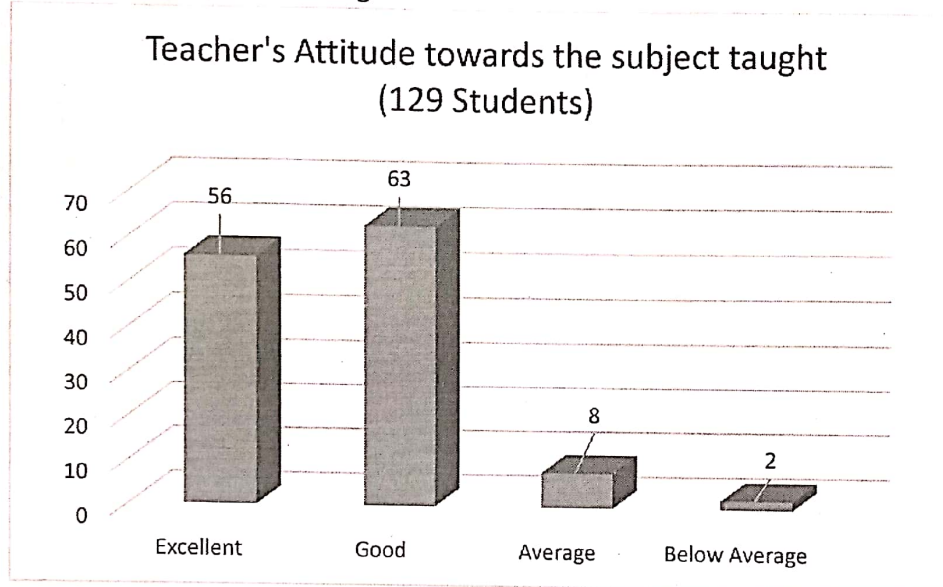
3. The teacher is Knowledgeable and Skills in explaining difficult points.

Very few students replied that teachers' knowledge is below average. The institute is asking teachers to satisfy the students in academic activities as well as their problem solving.



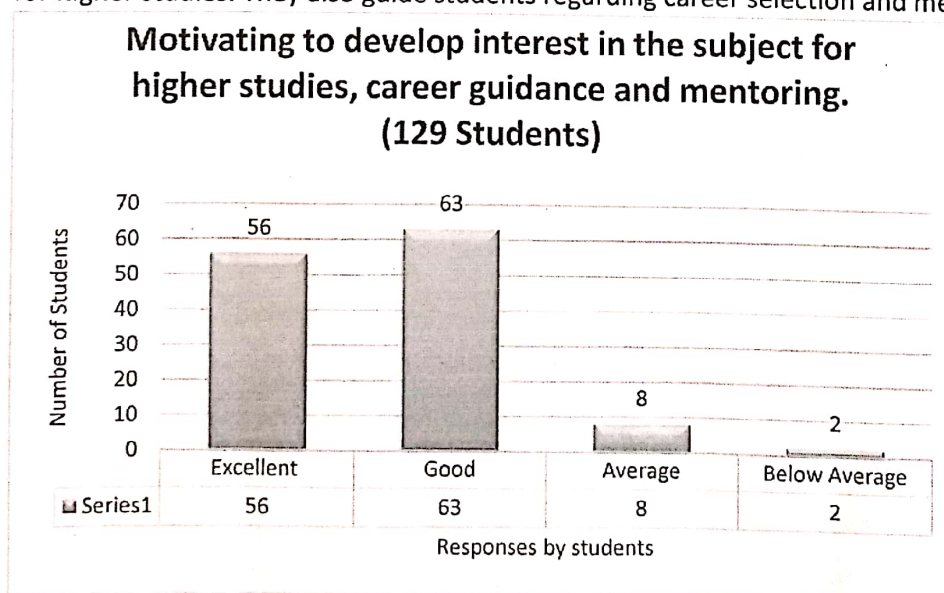
4. **Teacher's Attitude towards the subject taught and Cares about the students and to solve their difficulties**

As per the reply of teachers, Teachers has good attitude towards the subjects being taught. It is found that 43.41% (56) students, also replied that teachers are excellent to solve the difficulties and cares the students. 48.84% (63) students are of the same opinion with an answer as good. Only 1.55% (2) students are saying that their teacher's attitude is not good towards the subjects the taught.



5. **Motivating to develop interest in the subject for higher studies, career guidance and mentoring.**

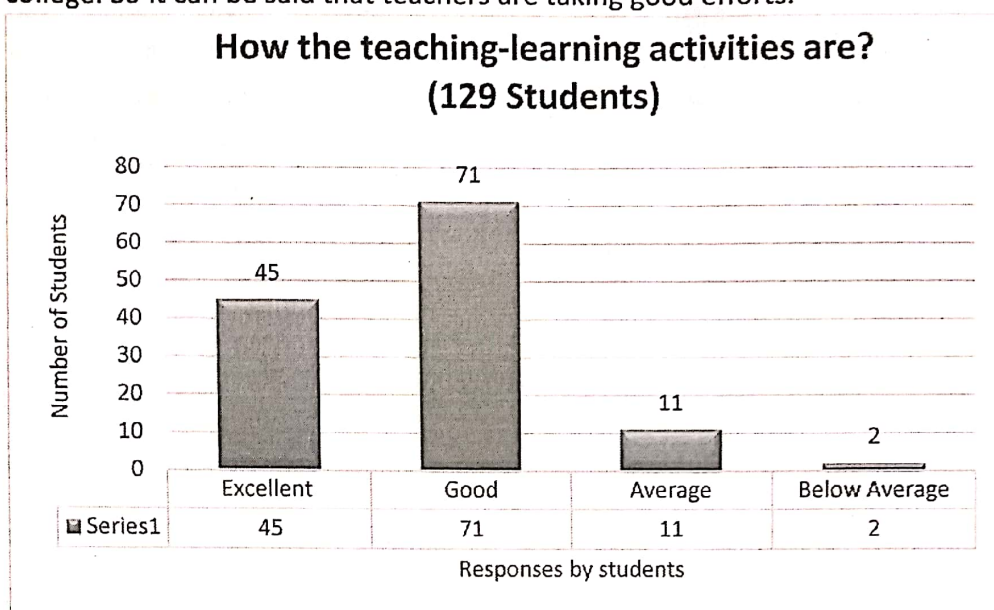

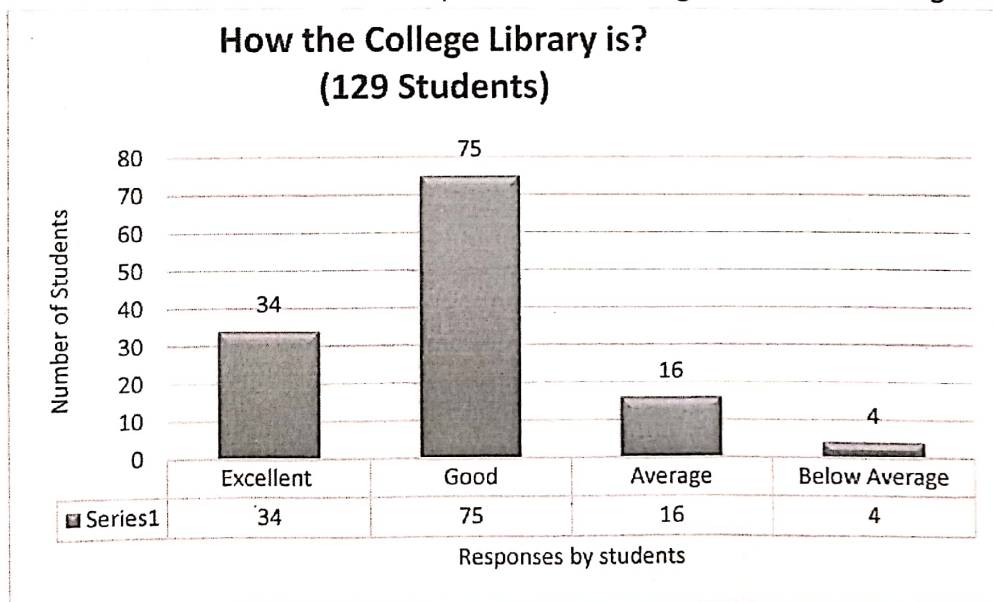
6. How the teaching-learning activities are?

7. How the College Library is? And facilities provided in library along with books?

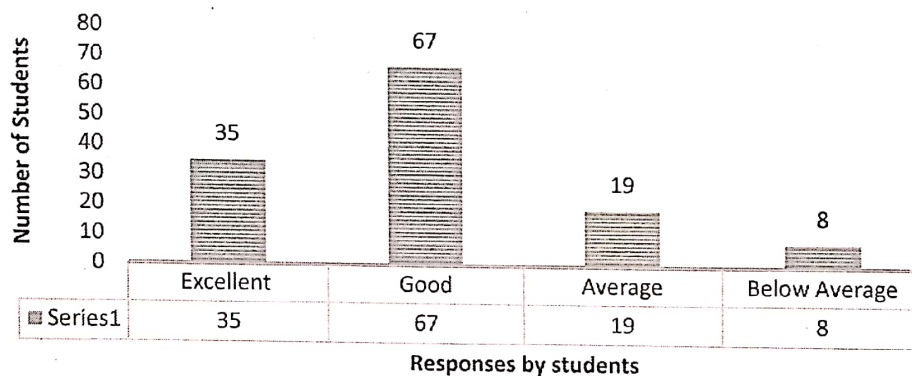

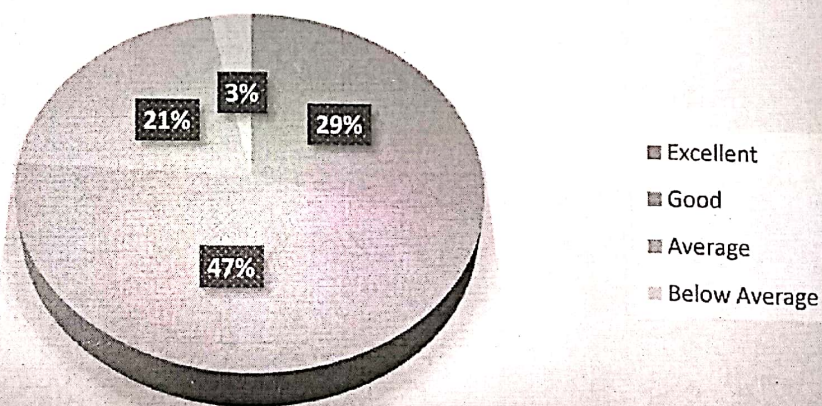
**OPINION ABOUT OTHER FACILITIES

Students are also satisfied with the games and sports activities.

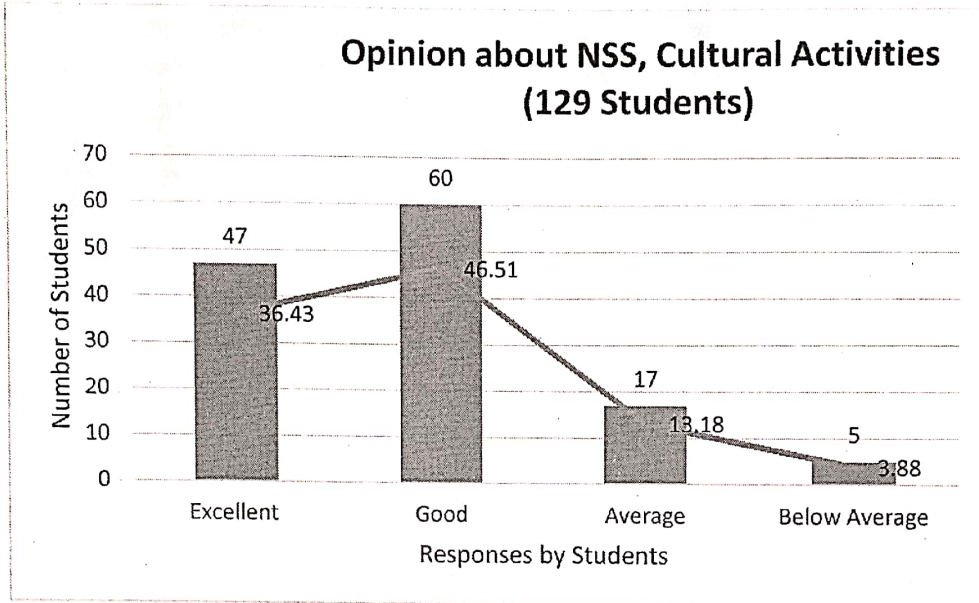
**Opinion about Games & Sports Activities?
(129 Students)**





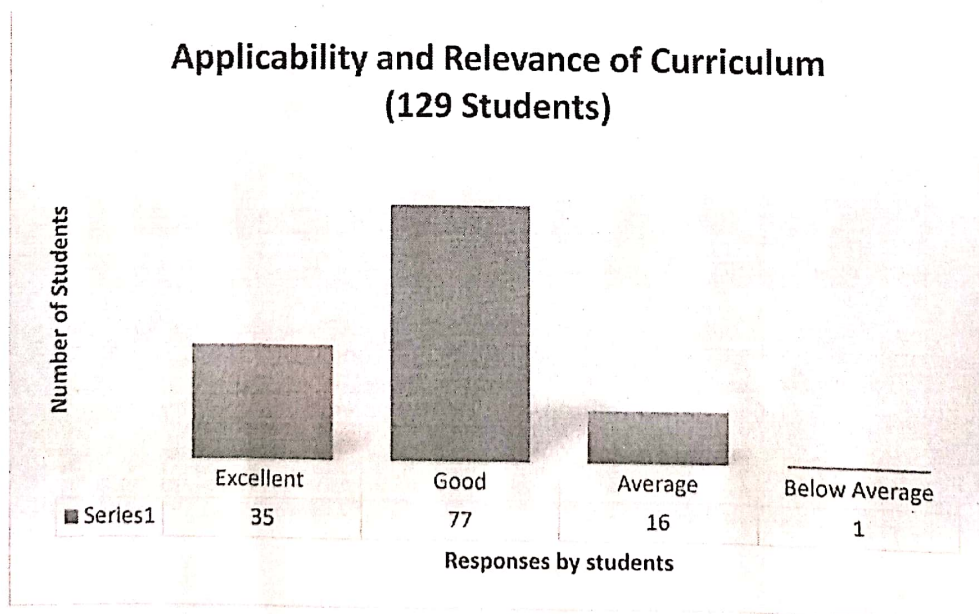
10. Opinion about NSS, Cultural Activities and other Extra-Curricular Activities?

11. Applicability and relevance Curriculum / Syllabus to real life situations & local developmental needs?

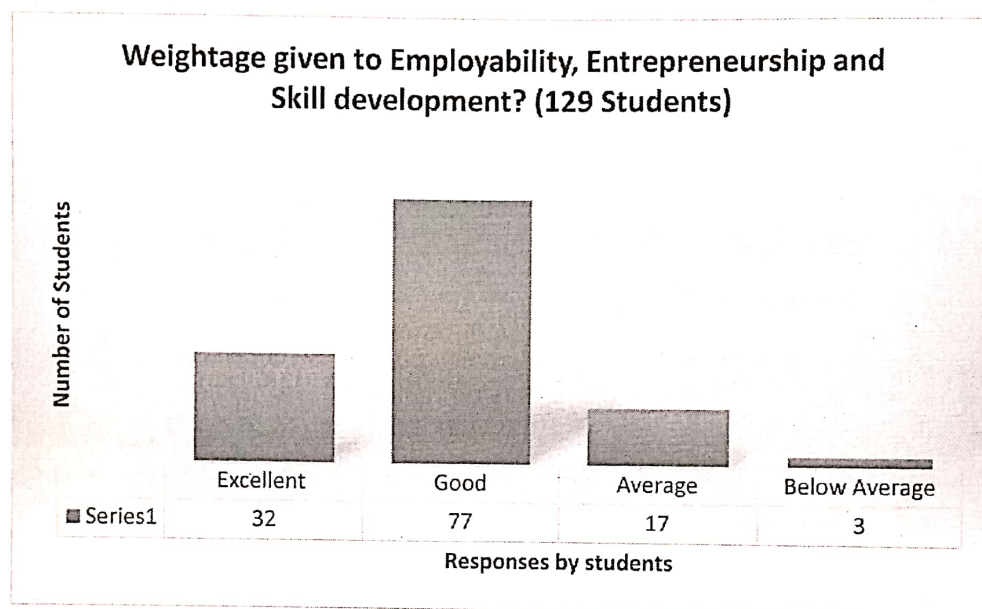

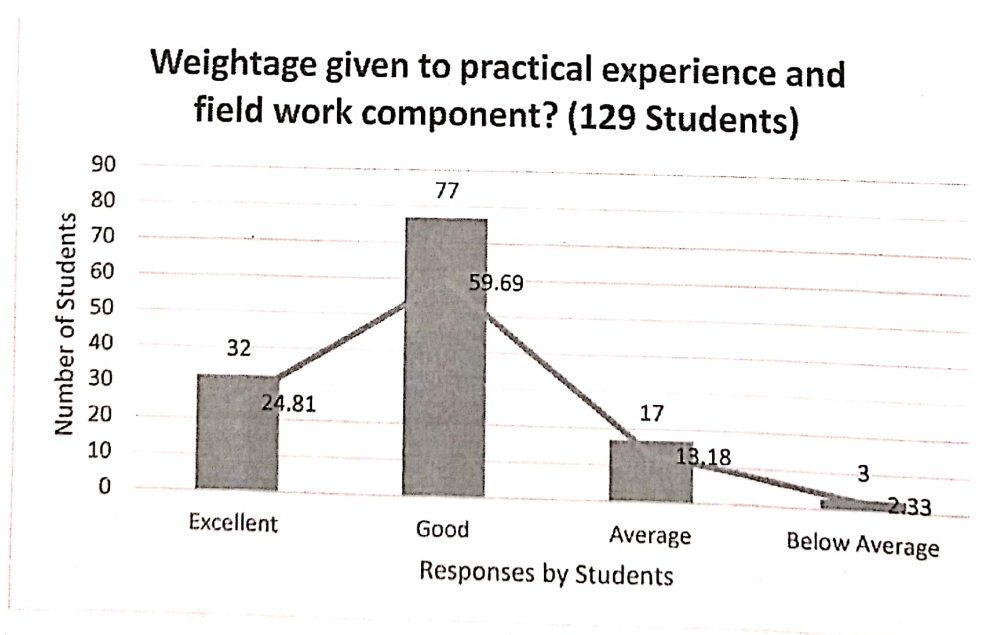
12. Weightage given to Employability, Entrepreneurship and Skill development?

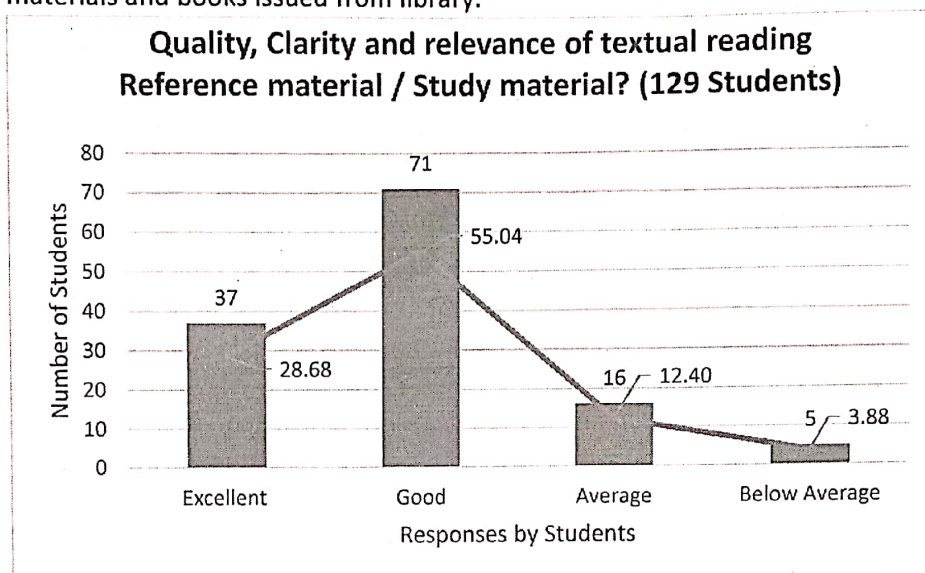
13. Weightage given to practical experience and field work component?

Field work, industrial visits and visits to historical places are regularly. Project Report activity is also undertaken for B.Com. Students regularly. So, students are satisfied with these activities.



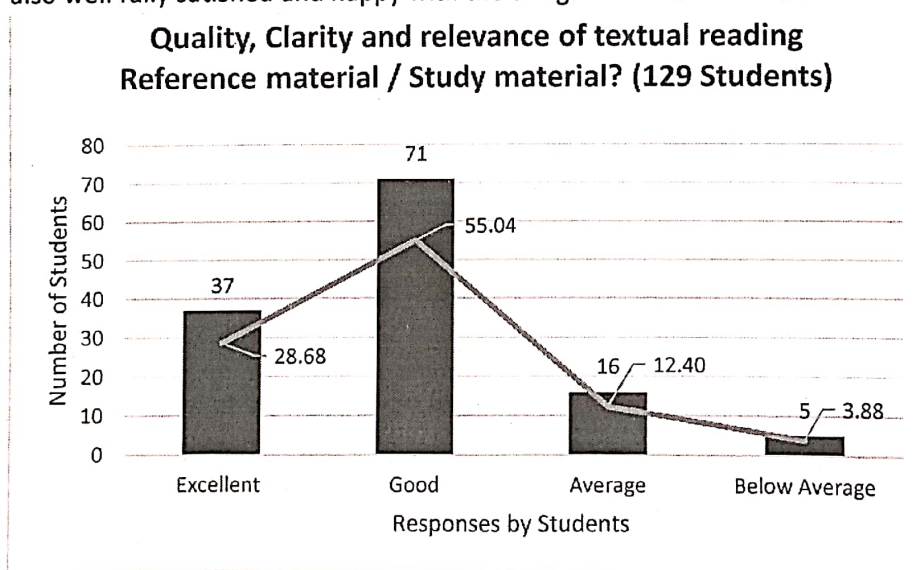
14. Quality, Clarity and relevance of textual reading / Reference material / Study material?
